Hathaway, in his will, claiming: "I gyve unto my wife my second best bed with the furniture". The "furniture" was the bedclothes for the bed.

4 24 of Uranus' 27 satellites are named after Shakespearean characters, including Titania, Ophelia, Juliet and Cupid!

5 Although it was illegal to be a Catholic in Shakespeare's lifetime, the Anglican Archdeacon, Richard Davies of Lichfield, who had known him in person, wrote after Shakespeare's death that he had been a Catholic.
