THE BRANDENBURGERS IN BOHEMIA AT THE NATIONAL MORAVIAN-SILESIAN THEATRE

THE BRANDENBURGERS IN BOHEMIA marks the revival of the first opera by Bedřich Smetana at the National Moravian-Silesian Theatre. This historical three-act opera from 1866 is part of the **Smetana Opera Cycle Ostrava 2024**, encompassing the performance of all completed operas by Smetana in two sequences in March and May of this year.

The opera's plot unfolds a year after the death of King Přemysl Otakar II when Margrave Otto of Brandenburg invaded and devastated Bohemia. A period of hardship followed, during which the Czech nation rose in resistance. The opera weaves together the power of words and revolutionary scenes depicting common people, intertwining with a romantic narrative of love and the fortunate rescue of democratic ideals. Widely known for its mass scenes, liberation themes, and romantic pathos, the opera likely draws inspiration from the popularity of French grand opera in Prague during that era. With this work, Bedřich Smetana intentionally aligned himself with the Czech national revival and the political program of national emancipation.

The opera is revived on the Ostrava stage after 8 years and will open ten-year endeavour to present Smetana's operatic oeuvre. "This idea emerged during our work on *The Devil's Wall* in 2014 when, together with the opera team, we realized that in 2024, 200 years would have passed since the birth of Bedřich Smetana. Additionally, we will commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Year of Czech Music, established in 1924 to honour Smetana's legacy," says NMST's Intendant and the production's director Jiří Nekvasil.

The musical direction is undertaken by the former Music Director of Opera Jakub Klecker: "Although *Brandenburgers* is the composer's first opera, in the context of Czech opera literature, this title holds a prominent position. Smetana skips the overture and, after a short dramatic introduction, immediately enters the action. The course of the whole work has a clear form, alternating between pious, lyrical, combative, and choral passages," says Jakub Klecker.

This is the 6th rendition of the opera *The Brandenburgers in Bohemia* in the NMST, whose original opening night took place on 9 and 11 June 2016.
